

Bend Elks Bat Boy/Girl Information Sheet

Age Restrictions: Ages 10 and up

What to wear: Comfortable clothing (often baseball/softball pants), closed-toe shoes, a lightweight shirt, and sweatshirt (it can get cold after the sunset). A batting helmet with a face shield will be provided by the Bend Elks. A helmet with a face shield is required to be worn at all times during the game. You can bring your own if you prefer.

What to bring: Water bottle (it can be refilled in the dugout), sunglasses, snacks (if desired), and sunscreen (the Bend Elks dugout is directly in the sun).

When to arrive: Please be ready to go to the dugout 30 minutes prior to the start of the game. When you arrive at the stadium, please check in at the will call table or ticket booth stating that you are the Bat Boy/Girl.

Safety Restrictions: Only one Bat Boy/Girl allowed per dugout per game. Bat Boy/Girl must stay in the dugout, behind the netting until the game on the filed has paused to get the bat. All Bat Boy/Girl(s) must be ages 10 or older.

How often: You can sign up to be Bat Boy/Girl for up to one game per week. If it is the day of the game and no one is signed up you can take that day, even if you have already done it that week.
